

An Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program

The cities below have entered into a cooperative agreement with the purpose to preserve the existing affordable housing stock in their communities.



Who is eligible for the Metro Home Improvement Program?

-  The property must be located within the participating cities and Polk County.
-  The assessed value of the home must be at or below \$300,000 (includes both land and building value per the Polk County Assessor).
-  The property must be a single-family residence, condominium or townhouse. *Houses being purchased under contract are not eligible.
-  The property must be the owner-occupied.
-  Property taxes, mortgage payments and homeowner's insurance must be current.
-  Income limits of the household must fall at or below 80% of the area median household income, which is based on HUD Annual Income as Defined in 24 CFR Part 5. (see chart below)

What are the financial implications to the homeowner?

- The work is paid for by the Program through funding from the Polk County Housing Trust Fund and the participating cities.
- The financial assistance will be in the form of a forgivable loan with a maximum loan amount of \$16,820 and a minimum loan amount of \$500.
- The loan will be recorded as a mortgage on the property with a term of five (5) years, decreasing 20% each year, and bearing no interest.
- The loan only comes due if the homeowner sells within the five years following the time of participation.

Program Eligible Activities Include:

-  **Basic structural repairs:**
(a) Exterior Walls (b) Roof and roof structure
(c) Foundation (d) Floor joists and ceilings
-  **Building Systems:**
(a) Electrical (b) Plumbing (c) Heating
-  **Weatherization:**
(a) Insulation (b) Windows (c) Siding
-  **Handicap Accessibility:**
(a) Exterior ramp (b) Bathroom facilities
-  **Sump pump installation & connection to storm sewer**
