#### **ISSUE: MIPA Designation as a Council of Governments**

REPORT: Report on MIPA seeking Council of Governments designation from the State of Iowa.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On September 30, MIPA staff emailed all member community representatives to inform them of the upcoming opportunity for MIPA to pursue official State COG Designation during the next legislative session. Staff also offered to present on the topic at city council and supervisors meetings.

Staff has mostly received positive feedback from member communities that have inquired about the initiative. In addition to member communities, staff also notified the City of Des Moines, City of Altoona, Polk County, and Dallas County but has not received a response.

At the November 17th MIPA Executive Committee meeting, the Executive Committee unanimously recommended moving forward with seeking COG designation. A subsequent vote by the Board of Directors is needed to approve of MIPA seeking COG designation.
